HOW TO USE THIS INDEX: Most feature material has been indexed three or more times—once by the title under which it was published, again under the author's last name, and finally under one or more of the subject categories or railroads. Photographs standing alone, as in the "News" section, "Railroad News Photos," "Photo Section," or departments, are indexed (usually under the railroad), but photographs within a single-subject feature are not usually separately indexed. News items are indexed under the railroad and/or category. References to people, or quotes by them, are indexed under the railroad or company with which they are easily identified; if there is no such easy identification, they are indexed under the person's last name. Maps, radio frequencies, and rosters of locomotives and equipment are indexed under those categories. (Unless otherwise indicated, "rosters" are of diesel locomotives.) Items from foreign countries (other than the United States and Canada) are indexed under the country. Numerals are indexed in alphabetical order as if spelled out; "article" words (a, an, the) are omitted when alphabetizing an index.
